

## **OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, DARRANG, MANGALDAI**

### **ORDER**

Dated, 24.01.2022

Pursuant to Notification No. 03, dated 06.01.2022 and Notification No. 08, dated 19.01.2022 issued by the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court and considering the recent surge in the COVID situation in the state of Assam, following arrangements are hereby made for functioning of the Courts in the Darrang District Judiciary.

1. All Courts shall take up limited number of cases. However, the concerned Presiding Officer may hear/ take up any other item which is deemed to be utmost importance and urgency.
2. Cases will be heard both in virtual and hybrid mode as per the discretion and convenience of the Court. The cases already fixed in the "Daily Cause List" shall be taken up as per the discretion and convenience of the Courts as well as the Learned Advocates and Litigants, in terms of the Notification No. 03, dated 06.01.2022 from the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court.
3. Based on the list of cases notified in the Cause-list, the concerned Learned Advocate /party-in- person shall have to contact the contact person., (as notified in Annexure I). All Learned Advocates are encouraged, as far as possible to argue their cases from their residence to minimize footfalls in the court premises.
4. The Learned Advocates shall inform the Court at least 3 (three) days in advance in the event of any urgent matters for hearing. The same shall be included in the cause list after consideration by the concerned Presiding Officer.
5. Hard copies of urgent petitions such as Bail matters, Injunction matters etc. are to be deposited in the Boxes placed outside the respective Court halls, at least 1 day in advance and soft copies of the same must be emailed to the following email ids:-

6. All the UTPs may be produced through Video Conferencing except first production and recording of statement u/s 164 of the Cr. P.C.
7. The evidence of M.O. / I.O. may be recorded through video conferencing.
8. Entry inside the Court premises shall be restricted. Only Learned Advocates/ Litigants whose presence are necessary and Court staff shall be permitted to enter the Court premises on production of final COVID vaccination certificate.
9. Non-vaccinated/ partially vaccinated learned Advocates/ litigants/ Court staff shall be permitted to enter the Court premises only after production of a Negative RT-PCR test report not older than 48 hours.

10. Wearing of face masks and maintaining social distancing shall be mandatory inside the Court premises.
11. All stakeholders of the court, including Officers, Advocates, Litigants, Staff and Security staff etc. shall have to undergo thermal testing, before entering the court complex.
12. A Register shall be maintained in the entry point recording the name, address and phone number of every outsider entering the Court premises.
13. The Head Assistant shall ensure sanitization of the chambers, court halls and offices of the entire building after Court hours on a day to day basis.
14. Canteen inside the Court premises shall operate in a restricted mode with only take away facility.
